SCHOOL FEES FOR 2017

The Governing Body has prepared a detailed budget for 2017, which includes provision for the school fees payable by parents and which are required in order to meet the budgetary requirements. This budget was presented to parents at a meeting convened on 24 October 2016. Approval for the budget and the proposed school fees was adopted by a resolution of all parents present at the meeting.

The Junior School's fees for 2017 are accordingly R40 400 per year. In addition to this, parents are expected to pay for certain textbooks, stationery, sports equipment and all items of school clothing, as well as to pay for camps, music tuition and certain extramural activities available at, or through, the School.

School fees in 2017 will be charged annually in advance and may be paid : 1) by EFT into the School's bank account or preferably by debit order, in ten equal instalments due on the 1st day of the month from February to November. 2) by EFT in 4 equal instalments due on the 1st day of each term. 3) by EFT in a lump sum by 31 January 2017, in which case a discount R1210 will apply. If you wish to switch to debit order, kindly collect the relevant forms from our Admissions Secretary.

All expenses for the forthcoming year were budgeted on a zero basis, i.e. expenses have not been justified by applying a simple inflationary increase to the previous budget. Further, the budget has been based on a high rate of recovery, as this has been achieved historically.

The voluntary contribution to the Building & Development Fund remains the same at R2 500 per family per year. This levy enables the School to grow through various capital development projects, and plan for the future. This is critical to allow us to maintain our position as one of South Africa's finest educational institutions. **If you will be contributing to this via the Grade R or High School please notify the Bursar in writing.**
